



STANDING ORDERS

THE FOLLOWING STANDING ORDERS APPLY TO ALL NSCC PERSONNEL. FAILURE TO OBEY STANDING ORDERS MAY RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, UP TO AND INCLUDING YOUR DISMISSAL FROM THIS THE EVOLUTION.

1. There will be **NO** Fraternization.
2. There will be **NO** Profanity, Name Calling, False Accusations and Verbal Abuse of any kind.
3. There will be **NO** Consumption of Drugs, Alcohol and/or Tobacco Products.
4. There will be **NO** Fighting, Horseplay or Malingering (Faking).
5. **Cadets may not be away from their spaces after taps (2200 hours, 10:00 PM)**, unless properly authorized by the Commanding Officer.
6. All personnel will be in the proper uniform of the day at all times, unless the Commanding Officer specifies otherwise.
7. All personnel will keep their spaces squared away and their personal gear secured at all times. Spaces not passing inspection must be squared away before departing the living quarters. Gear found adrift will be confiscated.
8. Report all illnesses, concerns, questions to the Commanding Officer. If the Commanding Officer is not available, the illness, concerns, questions will be reported to any adult staff member (including Midshipmen).
9. All personnel are required to drink at least one large glass of water with each meal.
10. All personnel are responsible for knowing the content of the Plan-of-the-Day. Read it and ask questions, if necessary.
11. All personnel will report to every muster on time.
